In addition to financing private music lessons for middle and high school students, Music4CHIEF also offers a yearly needs-based grant awarded to one Forsyth County high school marching band student. The recipient of the Music4CHIEF Marching Band Grant will receive an **award of \$500*** paid to the marching band program to help reduce the financial requirement for the 2022 marching band season.

This scholarship is open to rising 9th through rising 12th grade marching band students attending one of the Forsyth County public high schools (North Forsyth, Forsyth Central, West Forsyth, South Forsyth, Lambert, Denmark). All required documents must be submitted with the application.

At the beginning of the 2022 school year, scholarship funds will be paid directly to the winning student's high school band program for credit towards the student's band fees. In the event the student, for whatever reason, resigns from the marching band program before the end of the season, the high school band program will retain the remainder of grant funds to cover expenses incurred.

Relatives of Music4CHIEF Board of Directors are not eligible for this scholarship.
